

## European Parliament Parliament's powers

### Legislative power

Most EU laws are adopted jointly by the European Parliament and the Council of the EU





### **Parliamentary control**

Parliament supervises other EU institutions and can pass a vote of no-confidence in the European Commission

### Parliament decides the EU annual budget together with the Council

**Budgetary power** 

Parliament's assent is required for the accession of any new Member States

**Enlargement decisions**



Situation as of 14 December 2011








## Parliament's calendar: 2012






## Budget of the European Union Expenditure 2012




Total: EUR 129,1 billion

## The ordinary legislative procedure Schematic overview




